

MINUTES
Regular Meeting
City of DeCordova
September 21, 2021

Mayor Dave Hanson called the Regular Monthly City Council Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Opal Durant Acton Community Center. All councilmembers were present.

INVOCATION: Councilmember David Coop

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Councilmember Jim Gallman

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Councilmember Bailey moved that the Minutes of the June 15, 2021, Regular Meeting be approved, seconded by Councilmember Gallman. Unanimously approved.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

- A) Mayor Hanson noted the EMS /VFD reports for June and July 2021.
- B) Mayor Hanson noted the June, July and August 2021 Security Synopsis reports.

BUSINESS:

- A) City Secretary, Marla Frye installed the new Place 2 Councilmember, Jennifer White.
- B) Mayor Hanson asked for the clarification of the year model of the security vehicle donated in April 2021 to DeCordova Bend Estates as a 2016 vehicle. It was stated as a 2017 vehicle in the April 2021 minutes. A motion was made by Councilmember Cordell to accept the change of security vehicle year to 2016, seconded by Councilmember Gallman. Unanimously approved.
- C) Mayor Hanson discussed extending of the 2020-2021 budget to allow a 30-day notice of the 2021-2022 budget hearing. A motion was made to extend the 2020-2021 budget by Councilmember Coop, seconded by Councilmember White. Unanimously approved.
- D) Mayor Hanson discussed the proposed budget.
- E) Mayor Hanson discussed the American Rescue Plan Act.
- F) Councilmember Coop discussed the Broadband Internet information and reported nothing new to report.
- G) Mayor Hanson discussed water issues concerning drainage and engineering reports on new builds and remodels causing possible flooding issues. The issue was tabled for additional information gathering.
- H) Mayor Hanson discussed the ongoing opioid class action law suit that involves Texas cities.
- I) The Treasurer's Reports for June, July and August 2021 were given by City Secretary/Treasurer, Marla Frye. The reports were accepted.

A motion was made by Councilmember Bailey, seconded by Councilmember Cordell to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting was adjourned at 7:45.
